SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 7th, 2 - 6

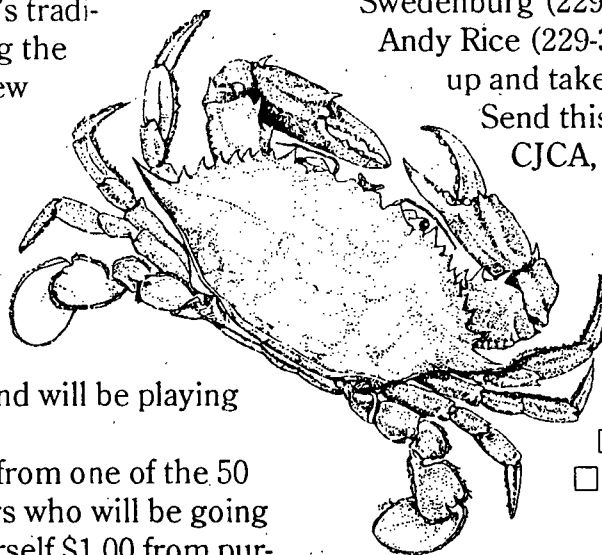

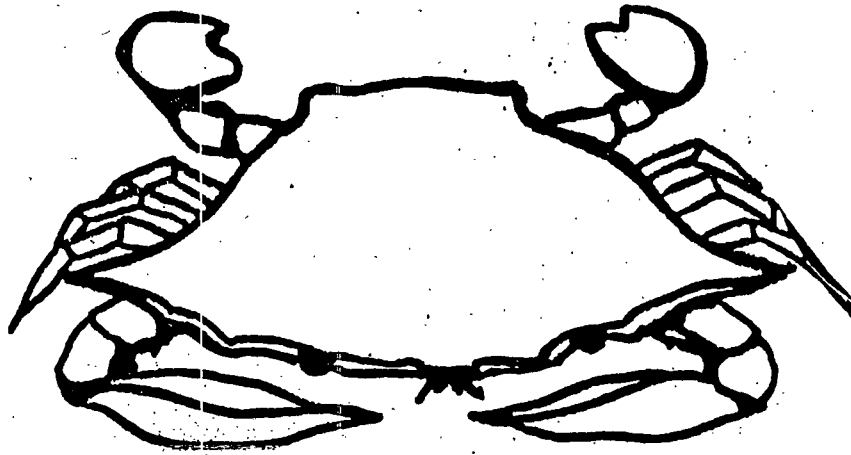
